The 9-Minute Devotional Plan

Ponder His Word

Read and think about it.
Meditate on his word, work, and worth
Journal your prayer to God

Praise His Worth

Sing to the Lord – sing and rejoice
Exalt his name – tell of his greatness
Give thanks – good, bad, ugly

Petition His Will

Confess your sins, faults, failures
Tell God your troubles
As specific things of God – believe for good things

Hints for Enjoying Prayer

- Practice Quiet Times – closet, door, alone
- Use a 3-Minute Timer – focus!
- Journal - your prayers & thoughts
- Meditate – on creation, works, cross, etc
- Have a Plan – *failure to plan is plan to fail*
- Vary Positions – stand, kneel, lay, raise hands, etc.
- Schedule God! – don't leave him off day-timer
- Prayer Day – once a month 2 hrs to 8 hrs
- Prayer Retreat – 3 times per year alone with God
