Exodus 35:

5. From what you have, take an offering for the LORD. Everyone who is willing is to bring to the LORD an offering of gold, silver and bronze;

10. "All who are skilled among you are to come and make everything the LORD has commanded:

21. and everyone who was willing and whose heart moved him came and brought an offering to the LORD for the work on the Tent of Meeting

24. They all presented their gold as a wave offering to the LORD. 23. **Everyone** who had blue, purple or scarlet yarn or fine linen, or goat hair, ram skins dyed red or hides of sea cows brought them. 24. Those presenting an offering of silver or bronze brought it as an offering to the LORD, and **everyone** who had acacia wood for any part of the work brought it. 25. **Every skilled woman** spun with her hands.

29. **All the Israelite men and women** who were willing brought to the LORD freewill offerings for all the work the LORD through Moses had commanded them to do.

Malachi 1:6-8

6. "A son honors his father, and a servant his master. If I am a father, where is the honor due me? If I am a master, where is the respect due me?" says the LORD Almighty. "It is you, O priests, who show contempt for my name. "But you ask, 'How have we shown contempt for your name?' 7. "You place defiled food on my altar. "But you ask, 'How have we defiled you?' "By saying that the LORD's table is contemptible. 8. When you bring blind animals for sacrifice, is that not wrong? When you sacrifice crippled or diseased animals, is that not wrong? Try offering them to your governor! Would he be pleased with you? Would he accept you?" says the LORD Almighty.

Revelation 5

11 Then I looked and heard the voice of many angels, numbering thousands upon thousands, and ten thousand times ten thousand. They encircled the throne and the living creatures and the elders. 12 In a loud voice they sang: "**Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!**" 13 Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, singing: "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!" 14 The four living creatures said, "Amen," and the elders fell down and worshiped.
